**When & Where:** The 4-H Summer Enrichment Program is a 2-day program held Wednesday, August 29 & Thursday, August 30, 2018 from 9:00 AM-1:00 PM at Parvin State Park 701 Almond Road, Pittsgrove Township, NJ. The meeting room is located by the entrance to the swimming beach.

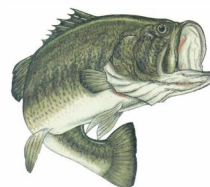
**Who Can Attend?** This program is open to boys and girls who have *completed* 2nd-5th grades. Both 4-H members and non 4-H members are welcome to attend.

The 4-H Youth Development Program is part of Rutgers Cooperative Extension, a unit of the New Jersey Agricultural Experiment Station. 4-H educational programs are offered to all youth, grades K-13, on an age-appropriate basis, without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, disability, atypical hereditary cellular or blood trait, marital status, domestic partnership status, military service, veteran status, and any other category protected by law.

**What is the Cost?** Cost is \$40 per child which covers program materials, activity supplies and crafts.

### **What Happens?**

Activities are based on the theme “***Reeling in the Fun.***”



Children will learn all about fish and their local waterways. They will learn about local fish species, fish identification and habitats.

The youth will have an opportunity to go fishing in the lake at Parvin State Park. Youth may bring a fishing pole but it is not required.

Children will take part in hands-on science activities; arts and crafts and group activities.

### **Program Staff and Supervision**

The 4-H Summer Enrichment Program is coordinated by the Cumberland County 4-H Youth Development Program staff. Adult 4-H volunteer leaders, teen 4-H members and 4-H staff will conduct program activities.

Children need to bring their lunch and a beverage each day.
