
We will also be offering the Boot & Bridle Medal Equitation Class.

PRE-CHILDREN'S/PRE-ADULT EQUITATION: This division is open to horses ridden by Junior and Adult Amateurs. Courses to be set at 2' with no less than (6) fences. Riders may not have shown over 2'6" or cross over to 3' division at same show.

PRE-CHILDREN'S/PRE-ADULT HUNTER: This division is open to horses ridden by Junior and Adult Amateurs. Ponies must be ridden by Juniors. Ponies must have ECSJ or USEF pony measurement card. Pre-Childrens/Pre-Adult all ponies will jump 2' all horses will jump 2'6".

LOW/WORKING HUNTER: This division is open to horses and ponies. Ponies may be ridden by an adult. Suitability to count. In and Out, if there is one, it is not to be altered for ponies and is recommended to be set at 24 feet. A horse or pony may compete in one section only per show (Low or Working). Low to jump 2'6", Working to jump 3'. This division may be separated into two divisions, Low Hunter and Working Hunter. If this is the case, at the Show Producers discretion, an additional fence height of 3'6" may be added to Working Hunter.

OPEN EQUITATION: To be judged on rider on the flat. Class 38 requires a test to be ridden during class.

*****ADDITIONAL CLASSES*****

THE BOOT & BRIDLE MEDAL: This is an Equitation class open to ECSJ members. This class will have a Final held at a fall ECSJ show. To qualify for the final is to win two ribbons. Points will also go to a year end award to be given at the ECSJ Awards banquet. Fence heights: Ponies 2' or 2'6" riders choice. Horses 2'6" to 3' riders choice.

TB Champion & Reserve for the day: To be awarded to the TB accumulating the most points for the day. This is determined by dividing points accumulated by number of classes entered. Must present Jockey Club papers or TIPS registration to be eligible.

TB Year End Awards also to be given: Must compete in 3 shows to be eligible for Year End.

DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS

MINI-STIRRUP: Open to riders grade 6 and under. May not cross enter into any classes that require horse or rider to canter. Never to have jumped at any show. Ground poles will be course.

SHORT-STIRRUP: Open to riders 12 and under (grades 4-8). Equitation division with points to follow rider. 18" verticals.

LONG-STIRRUP: Open to adult riders (18 & older only) with points to follow rider. 18" cross rails.

BEGINNING RIDER DIVISION: Open to all ages (grades 4 and over). Rider must not have won 3 blue ribbons in any performance or equitation class, with the exception of 4-H, lead line or mini-stirrup. 18" cross rails.

PLEASURE HORSE OR PONY: This division is open to horses and ponies. Ponies must possess a valid ECSJ or USEF measurement card. Pleasure horse/Pleasure pony may be split into two classes. Ponies may be ridden by an adult. Cross rails at 18" heights.

LEAD LINE: Judged on riders equitation and control of horse or pony.

BEGINNER HUNTER HORSE OR PONY: Open to horses or ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing and have never jumped courses over 2' in height at any show. Trotting on course or simple changes not to be penalized. To be judged on manners and way of going suitable for the hunter ring

MODEL HUNTER IN HAND: To be shown in hand in an English bridle. To be judged on conformation and way of going.

CONFORMATION HUNTER: To be shown under saddle walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring then horse is to have saddle removed and shown in hand. Judged on way of going as a hunter and conformation of ideal hunter type.

BABY GREEN HUNTER: Open to horses and ponies in their 1st and 2nd year of showing who have not shown over fences exceeding 2'3". Ponies must have an ECSJ or USEF measurement card. Horses and ponies to jump 2' to 2'3" fences.
